

INFORMATION FOR AUTHORS

1. *Contributions* should follow the general style of earlier issues, and the Style Manual for Authors Editors and Printers (5th Edition) of the Australian Government Publishing Service.

2. *Manuscripts* not normally to exceed 4,500 words, should be typed on A4 (297 x 210mm) paper, double spaced throughout and with wide margins on all four sides. Manuscripts will not be returned to authors. Submission as an email attachment (MSWord) is acceptable and welcomed.

3. *Title page* for the manuscript should show the title of the article, the name(s) and affiliation(s) of the authors, a running head and at the bottom of the page, the name and address (including postal code) and if available the email address of the person to whom proofs should be sent.

4. *References* are given at the end of the text as endnotes. All references cited in the text must appear in the reference list.

5. *Blind review*. *PHRONEMA* has provision for blind review in which the author's identity is anonymous to the referees. Blind review will only be provided when explicitly requested by the author and when the manuscript is submitted appropriately.

Upon acceptance of their article for publication, authors should submit a copy of their work on disk in addition to the final printed copies or as an email attachment. Address contributions and correspondence to:
