

INFORMATION FOR AUTHORS

1. Contributions should follow the general style of earlier issues, and the *Style Manual for Authors Editors and Printers* (5th Edition) of the Australian Government Publishing Service.
2. Manuscripts not normally to exceed 4,500 words, should be typed on A4 (297 x 210mm) paper, double spaced throughout and with wide margins on all four sides. Manuscripts will not be returned to authors. Submission as an email attachment (MSWord) is preferred.
3. Title page for the manuscript should show the title of the article, the name(s) and affiliation(s) of the authors, a running head and at the bottom of the page, the name and address (including postal code) and the email address of the person to whom proofs should be sent.
4. Abstract. An abstract of around 100 words that provides a synopsis of the article and that is suitable for indexing should be provided on a separate sheet after the title page.
5. Blind Review. PHRONEMA provides for blind review in which the author's identity is anonymous to the referees.
6. Contributions. Each contribution should be an original work and should not have been published previously. The contributor warrants that the contribution is in no way whatever a violation of any existing copyright, or a breach of any existing agreement, and that all statements in the contribution purporting to be facts are true and will indemnify the Publisher against any loss, injury or damage occasioned by the Publisher in consequence of any breach of this warranty or arising out of any claim that the contribution constitutes an infringement of copyright or contains defamatory or libelous matter.
7. References are given at the end of the text as endnotes. All references cited in the text must appear in the reference list.
